

GALATZÓ - SA VINYA

Start: Casas de Galatzó

Finish: Sa Vinya

Distance: 7.440 m

Altitude: 181 / 425 m

Estimate time required: 2 h 30 min

Difficulty: Easy/medium

Heritage sites on the route: The houses of Galatzó, the grain store at Galatzó, the ethnographic site of Es Tramuntanal, the archaeological site at Es Tramuntanal, the legend of s'Argolla, the viewpoint at s'Argolla, the Font dels Obis spring, the stone dwellings at Sa Vinya, the viewpoint at Sa Vinya, the ethnological site linked to the charcoal industry of Sa Vinya

Description: This route lies to the south-west of the Galatzó estate, linking the buildings of the country estate with the former agricultural area of Sa Vinya and the neighbouring estate of S'Alqueria. The route passes through the crop fields typical of a mountain estate. Along the way we can see interesting examples of dry-stone constructions (terraces, threshing floors, fountains, drinking troughs, charcoal kilns, and even ovens). We can also observe the fauna and flora typical of the Sierra de Tramuntana - in particular, it is possible to see Mallorcan wild goats or even booted eagles - while following the trail through holm oaks, pines and rock roses. The route comes to an end at an altitude of 425 metres at the top of a beautiful valley which, flanked by El Puig de Sa Panada, directs your eye over the farmland of the estate.
